Expectations for learning

Hope Academy learners are smart, punctual, prepared and meet the expectations for learning each day. We have established a clear set of systems to ensure students meet these expectations and will challenge and support those students who don't.

Successful learners at Hope Academy are smart

Blazer: Hope Academy blazer should be worn at all times

Jumper: Grey, Hope Academy long sleeved V-necked jumper should be worn beneath the blazer

Trousers: Formal black trousers. They must be black, plain smart trousers. They must not be low rise, skinny fit, tight fitting, denim/jean or chino trousers

Shirt: Plain white and formal style shirt with a collar (no motifs). Shirts should be tucked in at all times

Year 7 tie: Blue tie with gold logo

Skirt or Pinafore: Hope Academy 'Holyrood' school skirt or Pinafore dress. The skirt/pinafore dress must be knee length. The logo at the top of the skirt must be visible

Socks: Socks worn with trousers must be **black**. Socks worn with a skirt or pinafore must be knee length and **white**. They must not be patterned or have any bows

Shoes: Formal plain black shoes that will take a polish. Students are not permitted to wear black trainers, canvas shoes or boots. Shoes with studs and logos are not permitted

School bag: Students should have a suitable bag that is appropriate to carry books to and from school and protect the contents from the elements.

Coats: Outdoor coats are not to be worn inside the Academy building

PE Kit: Only approved Hope Academy sportswear is permitted for PE lesson and sporting events, further details of the PE kit are displayed on the Academy website. Students are expected to bring PE kit, even if they are ill or injured

Make-up/Jewellery/Nails and hairstyle: Students are not allowed to wear make-up or jewellery of any form, nails must be natural and unpolished and extreme hairstyles are not permitted. Students may wear plain black hair accessories

The Academy uniform must be strictly adhered to, the Academy will provide temporary replacement uniform to students who choose not to wear the accepted uniform. Please see the uniform section of the Academy website for further details.



- ✓ Calculator (available to purchase from the maths department)


Successful learners at Hope academy meet the expectations for learning

At Hope Academy we have a simple set of expectations that students are rewarded for when they meet these expectations




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If a student decides to make a choice not to follow the core values of the Academy there is a clear system that's teacher will follow, each step of the system has a particular consequence.



Once a student is given a C3 parents will be contacted. Further details on the behaviour management policy are available on the Academy website.

Mobile phones

Electronic devices such as mobile phones and MP3 players are not permitted to be used during the Academy day due to the potential disruption they can cause. If a student does need to bring a mobile phone with them it must be switched off and stored inside a student's bag whilst they are on the Academy site. Any communication between students and parents during the school day must be through student services. Students will have mobile phones and MP3 players confiscated if they are seen during the school day. Parents will need to collect the phone from the Academy should this become a persistent problem. We are currently reviewing this process and will update the Academy website should there be any change to this process.
